## SPIRITUALISTS GOOD FRIDAY RALLY 2020

Applications for stallholders, craft & therapy spaces are welcomed by The Good Friday Rally team. **Please read all through these terms and conditions.**

FOR STALLHOLDERS & CRAFT STALLS we will provide one pitch of 6 feet x 4.6 feet space, and will include at least one chair, in the MAIN DANCE ROOM of the venue.

FOR EACH THERAPY Consultant space we will provide one pitch of 6 feet x 4.6 feet space, and will include at least one chair, in the MAIN DANCE ROOM of the venue.

Some pitches will be near electricity sockets and if this is required the stallholder/therapy consultant **must** make this clear when first enquiring about availability. Any electrical items to be used on the day, must be current PAT marked, 500 watts max, and the responsible placement of cables will be *that* space users responsibility.

A space is not considered as booked until payment is made of £25.00 per 6 feet required, so please pay promptly upon your successful enquiry. Once paid, a **photo** from your dressed stall or website is required for *our* website use. This is so that details of your attendance and therapy are viewed before the rally. Details of how to pay are given upon your application.

Therapists working on the day **must** have their own Public Liability Insurance, and a copy of this must be seen before the booking is confirmed.

Each space holder is required to be responsible for the removal and disposal of the rubbish from their stall/s or therapy area. Risk assessment available on request.

Any spillages at or adjacent to your space must be cleaned immediately. Candles may be on view for sale but not lit.

All stallholders and therapy space holders are responsible for their own health and safety and need to be mindful of keeping pathways and fire exits clear and free from any tripping hazards.

Entry to the venue will be possible from 8.00am – 9.15am, when all vehicles must be removed from around the venue entrance please.

The public will be admitted to the Spiritualists Rally at 9.30am and demonstrations and workshops start AT 10.00am.

All areas and content must start to clear at 5.00pm. The evening church service starts at 5.30pm.

ALL stallholders and therapy space holders are asked to contact Wodson Park Sports & Leisure Centre direct for information about loading and unloading restrictions. Telephone: **01920 487 091**  
There is a large car park at the venue and disabled spaces near the main entrance.
